**From Hero to Zero
back to Hero**

A. Matthew

16:13-19 vs

21-23 24-28

Matthew 16:13 (KJV)

**When Jesus came into the
coasts of Caesarea Philippi,
he asked his disciples,
saying, Whom do men say
that I the Son of man am?**

Matthew 16:14 (KJV)

**And they said, Some say that
thou art John the Baptist:
some, Elias; and others,
Jeremias, or one of the
prophets.**

Matthew 16:15 (KJV)

He saith unto them,

But whom say ye

that I am?

Matthew 16:16 (KJV)

And Simon Peter

answered and said,

Thou art the Christ, the

Son of the living God.

Matthew 16:17 (KJV)

**And Jesus answered and said
unto him, Blessed art thou,
Simon Barjona: for flesh and
blood hath not revealed it unto
thee, but my Father which is in
heaven.**

Matthew 16:18 (KJV)

**And I say also unto thee, That
thou art Peter, and upon this
rock I will build my church; and
the gates of hell shall not
prevail against it.**

Matthew 16:19 (KJV)

And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

Matthew 16:21 (KJV)

From that time forth began Jesus to shew unto his disciples, how that he must go unto Jerusalem, and suffer many things of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised again the third day.

Matthew 16:22 (KJV)

**Then Peter took him, and
began to rebuke him, saying,
Be it far from thee, Lord: this
shall not be unto thee.**

Matthew 16:23 (KJV)

But he turned, and said unto Peter, Get thee behind me, Satan: thou art an offence unto me: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but those that be of men.

Matthew 16:24 (KJV)

**Then said Jesus unto his
disciples, If any man will come
after me, let him deny himself,
and take up his cross, and
follow me.**

Matthew 16:25 (KJV)

**For whosoever will save his
life shall lose it: and
whosoever will lose his life
for my sake shall find it.**

Matthew 16:26 (KJV)

For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul?

Matthew 16:27 (KJV)

For the Son of man shall come in the glory of his Father with his angels; and then he shall reward every man according to his works.

Matthew 16:28 (KJV)

Verily I say unto you, There be some standing here, which shall not taste of death, till they see the Son of man coming in his kingdom.

B. Luke 22:31-34

vs 50-51 54-62

Luke 22:31 (KJV)

**And the Lord said, Simon,
Simon, behold, Satan
hath desired to have you,
that he may sift you as
wheat:**

Luke 22:32 (KJV)

**But I have prayed for thee,
that thy faith fail not: and
when thou art converted,
strengthen thy brethren.**

Luke 22:33 (KJV)

**And he said unto him,
Lord, I am ready to go
with thee, both into
prison, and to death.**

Luke 22:34 (KJV)

And he said, I tell thee, Peter,
the cock shall not crow this
day, before that thou shalt
thrice deny that thou
knowest me.

Luke 22:50 (KJV)

**And one of them smote
the servant of the high
priest, and cut off his
right ear.**

Luke 22:51 (KJV)

**And Jesus answered and
said, Suffer ye thus far. And
he touched his ear, and
healed him.**

Luke 22:54 (KJV)

**Then took they him, and led
him, and brought him into
the high priest's house.
And Peter followed afar off.**

Luke 22:55 (KJV)

**And when they had kindled
a fire in the midst of the hall,
and were set down together,
Peter sat down among them.**

Luke 22:56 (KJV)

**But a certain maid beheld him
as he sat by the fire, and
earnestly looked upon him, and
said, This man was also with
him.**

Luke 22:57 (KJV)

**And he denied him,
saying, Woman, I
know him not.**

Luke 22:58 (KJV)

**And after a little while another
saw him, and said, Thou art
also of them. And Peter said,
Man, I am not.**

Luke 22:59 (KJV)

**And about the space of one hour
after another confidently
affirmed, saying, Of a truth this
fellow also was with him: for he
is a Galilaean.**

Luke 22:60 (KJV)

**And Peter said, Man, I know
not what thou sayest. And
immediately, while he yet
spake, the cock crew.**

Luke 22:61 (NIV)

The Lord turned and looked straight at Peter. Then Peter remembered the word the Lord had spoken to him: “Before the rooster crows today, you will disown me three times.”

Luke 22:62 (NIV)

**And he went outside
and wept bitterly.**

C. John 18:10-11

vs 15-17 25, 27

John 18:10 (KJV)

Then Simon Peter having a sword drew it, and smote the high priest's servant, and cut off his right ear. The servant's name was Malchus.

John 18:11 (KJV)

**Then said Jesus unto Peter,
Put up thy sword into the
sheath: the cup which my
Father hath given me, shall I
not drink it?**

John 18:15 (KJV)

And Simon Peter followed Jesus, and so did another disciple: that disciple was known unto the high priest, and went in with Jesus into the palace of the high priest.

John 18:16 (KJV)

**But Peter stood at the door without.
Then went out that other disciple,
which was known unto the high
priest, and spake unto her that kept
the door, and brought in Peter.**

John 18:17 (KJV)

Then saith the damsel that kept the door unto Peter, Art not thou also one of this man's disciples? He saith, I am not.

John 18:25 (KJV)

And Simon Peter stood and warmed himself. They said therefore unto him, Art not thou also one of his disciples? He denied it, and said, I am not.

John 18:27 (KJV)

Peter then denied

again: and immediately

the cock crew.

D. Acts 2:13-14

vs 41

Acts 2:13 (KJV)

**Others mocking said,
These men are full of
new wine.**

Acts 2:14 (KJV)

But Peter, standing up with the eleven, lifted up his voice, and said unto them, Ye men of Judaea, and all ye that dwell at Jerusalem, be this known unto you, and hearken to my words:

Acts 2:41 (KJV)

**Then they that gladly received
his word were baptized: and
the same day there were
added unto them about three
thousand souls.**
