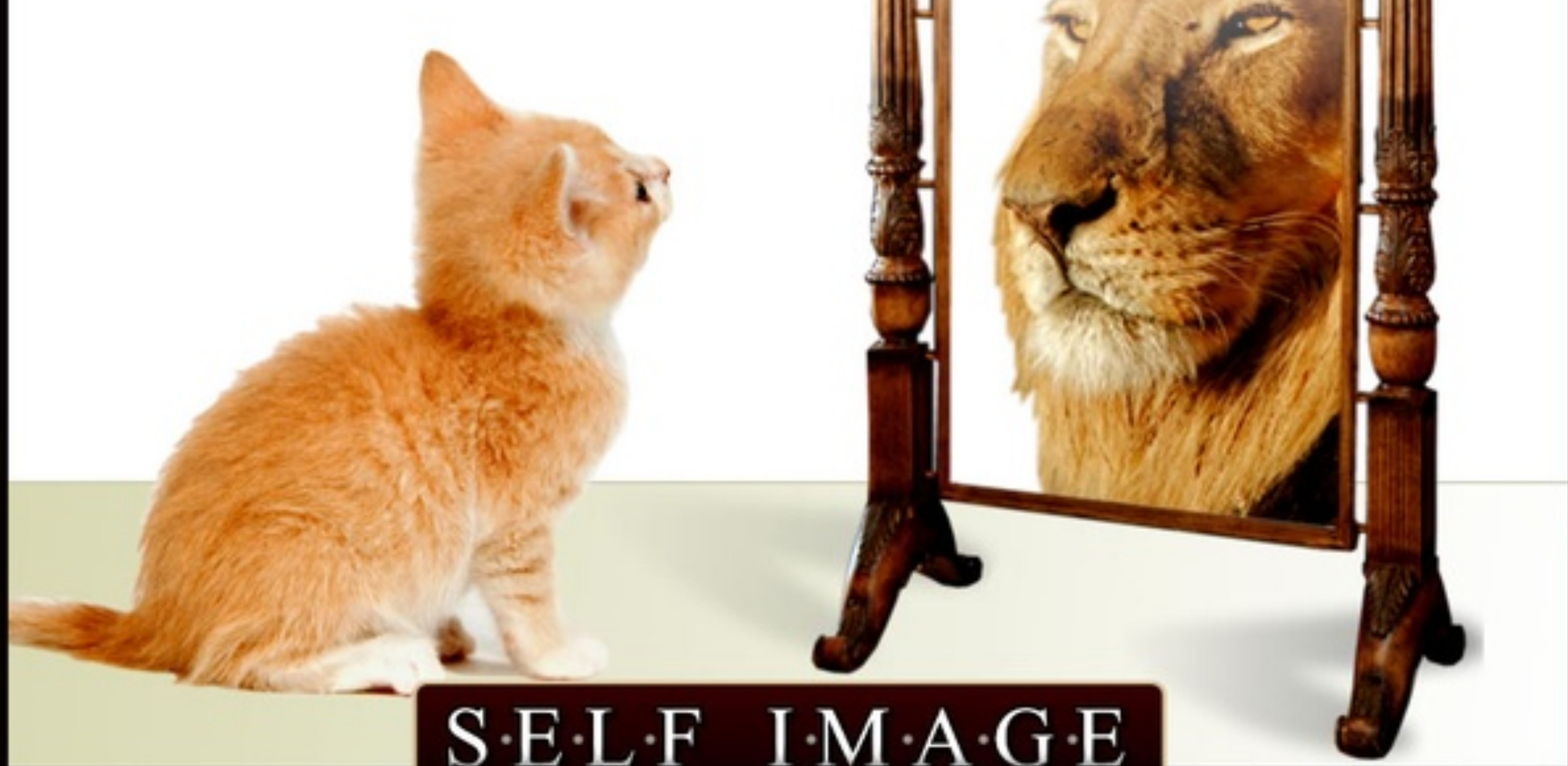

**6. Religion glorifies
Poverty by telling
us Jesus was poor**

Mark 14:4 (NIV)

**Some of those present
were saying indignantly
to one another, “Why
this waste of perfume?**

Mark 14:5 (NIV)

It could have been sold for more than a year's wages and the money given to the poor.” And they rebuked her harshly.

Mark 14:6 (NIV)

**“Leave her alone,” said
Jesus. “Why are you
bothering her? She has
done a beautiful thing to
me.**

Mark 14:7 (NIV)

**The poor you will always
have with you, and you can
help them any time you
want. But you will not
always have me.**

**7. You can't break
Poverty if you keep
viewing Jesus as
some poor man.**

Matthew 8:20 (NKJV)

And Jesus said to him,

**“Foxes have holes and
birds of the air have nests,
but the Son of Man has
nowhere to lay His head.”**

**8. You won't sow into
your leaders because
you'll think if Jesus was
poor why should I give
mere men my hard
earned money**

John 1:35 (NKJV)

**Again, the next day,
John stood with two of
his disciples.**

John 1:37 (NKJV)

**The two disciples
heard him speak, and
they followed Jesus.**

John 1:38 (NKJV)

Then Jesus turned, and seeing them following, said to them, “What do you seek?” They said to Him, “Rabbi” (which is to say, when translated, Teacher), “where are You staying?”

John 1:39 (NKJV)

He said to them, “Come and see.” They came and saw where He was staying, and remained with Him that day (now it was about the tenth hour).

And Jesus said to him,

**11. You will see that Jesus
was Ministry minded over
Money minded so
whenever money was
needed for ministry it was
always there.**

Matthew 17:24 (NKJV)

Peter and Jesus Pay Their Taxes

**When they had come to Capernaum,
those who received the temple tax
came to Peter and said, “Does your
Teacher not pay the temple tax?”**

Matthew 17:27 (NKJV)

**Nevertheless, lest we offend them,
go to the sea, cast in a hook, and
take the fish that comes up first.**

**And when you have opened its
mouth, you will find a piece of
money; take that and give it to them
for Me and you.”**

Luke 8:1 (NKJV)

**Now it came to pass, afterward,
that He went through every city
and village, preaching and
bringing the glad tidings of the
kingdom of God. And the twelve
were with Him,**

**and certain women who had
been healed of evil spirits and
infirmities — Mary called
Magdalene, out of whom had
come seven demons,**

Luke 8:3 (NKJV)

and Joanna the wife of Chuza,

Herod's steward, and

Susanna, and many others

who provided for Him from

their substance.

Matthew 27:55 (NKJV)

And many women who

followed Jesus from

Galilee, ministering to Him,

were there looking on from

afar,

**Matthew 27:56 (NKJV)
among whom were Mary
Magdalene, Mary the
mother of James and
Joses, and the mother of
Zebedee's sons.**

Matthew 27:57 (NKJV)

Jesus Buried in Joseph's Tomb

**Now when evening had come,
there came a rich man from
Arimathea, named Joseph, who
himself had also become a
disciple of Jesus.**

**Zaccheaus, Philip buying bread to
feed the 5 thousand, Judas
stealing from the pot, Peter John
James Andrew, Matthew was a tax
collector, and ultimately neither
the disciples or Jesus consider
themselves poor.**

**12. Jesus shows us that
temporary material poverty
can never outlast eternal
spiritual wealth especially
if you put God and His
ministry first**

break poverty like
Jesus we have to pass
the money vs ministry
test**

Psalms 105:37 (NKJV)

**He also brought them out
with silver and gold,
And there was none feeble
among His tribes.**

Exodus 25:2 (NKJV)

“Speak to the children of Israel, that they bring Me an offering. From everyone who gives it willingly with his heart you shall take My offering.

Exodus 25:3 (NKJV)

**And this is the offering
which you shall take from
them: gold, silver, and
bronze;**

**blue, purple, and scarlet
thread, fine linen, and

and stones to be set in the
ephod and in the breastplate.**

**And let them make Me

dwell among them.**
