









Genesis 21:9 (KJV) And Sarah saw the son of Hagar the Egyptian, which she had born unto Abraham, mocking.





Genesis 21:18 (KJV) Arise, lift up the lad, and hold him in thine hand; for will make him a




Genesis 21:19 (KJV) And God opened her eyes, and she saw a well of water; and she went, and filled the bottle with water, and gave the action of the second secon

Exocus 2:2 (KJV) And the woman conceived, and bare a son: and when she saw him that he was a goodly child, she hid him three months.






Exocus 2:4 (KJV) And his sister stood afar off, to wit what would be done to him.




Luke 1:26 (KJV) And in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent from God unto a city of Galilee, named Nazareth,

Luke 1:28 (KJV) And the angel came in unto her, and said, Hail, thou that art highly favoured, the Lord is with thee: blessed art thou among women.




Luke 1:29 (KJV) And when she saw him, she was troubled at his saying, and cast in her mind what manner of salutation this SIOU C DE




Luke 130 (KJV) And the angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary: for thou hast found favour

Luke 1:32 (KJV) He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the **Highest: and the Lord God** shall give unto him the throne of his father David:










Luke 1:34 (KJV) Then said Mary unto the angel, How shall this be, seeing know
